

CEREC Larose Trail Rules:

TRAIL RULES

- All riders must hold a valid CEREC seasonal trail pass or day pass.
- Stay on the marked and mapped trails, deviation will be considered trespassing.
- Restrict speed to safe levels. This includes appropriate consideration of other equestrians and trail conditions.
- Riders are responsible for obeying all signage, including but not limited to closed trails and speed restrictions.
- Proper, safe tack is mandatory. There is no bareback riding permitted.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets and heeled footwear.
- Unruly, abusive, or bad behavior on the part of a horse or human will lead to revocation of membership and/or day pass use of the trails
- Horses that kick must wear a red tail ribbon.
- Stallions must be marked with a yellow tail ribbon.
- Horses showing any signs of disease or poor health are prohibited from entering the CEREC trails. CEREC reserves the right to require any noncompliant horse or rider to be removed from the grounds.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

1. NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING either on the trails or in the parking lot.
2. No dogs permitted on the CEREC trails.
3. No open fires or barbecues on the grounds.

PARKING LOT RULES

1. All horses must be tied or hand held at all times and attended to by a responsible person.
3. Put all hay, manure and garbage **back in your trailer**.
4. ALL USERS are responsible for leaving the parking lot clean.
5. Do not park in a manner that blocks the access gate.

Rules have been determined in consultation with the land owners and land authorities. Continued access is conditional on your compliance.
